New this year is an afternoon, competitive tournament which is a gender blind, double elimination format. The registration fee for the afternoon tournament which begins at 12:30pm is \$45. Both fees include a tournament t-shirt, gift bag, and refreshments. Due to limited number of players, advanced registration is suggested to avoid being shut out.
