With summer right around the corner, there is no better time to explore the volunteer opportunities available to all. Currently, the museum is seeking individuals who are interested in welcoming visitors at the Maple Lane Complex, at the Nautical Museum at Horton Point Lighthouse, and/or at the shop in the historic Prince Building, as well as on other standing committees too.

Maple Lane Complex Docents (guides) facilitate the exploration of the historical complex buildings and grounds. There is much to discover! Hours at the complex are Saturday and Sunday 1-4pm June 29 to September 15.

Lighthouse Keepers (guides) at the Nautical Museum at Horton Point Lighthouse greet visitors and share their favorite artifacts/knowledge of the museum. Hours at the lighthouse are Saturday and Sunday 11:30am-4pm through September 15. Volunteering at the lighthouse is a special way to meet people from all over the region, country, and in some cases, world.

Treasure Exchange Shopkeepers assist shoppers in finding something special. Friendly faces are needed to help maintain the shop and ring up sales. Hours at the Treasure Exchange are Thursday and Friday 10am-4pm and Saturday from 11am-3pm.
