Southold Historical Society Offers 2021 Bainbridge Internship Deadline for applications May 15, 2021

The Board of Trustees of the Southold Historical Society is pleased to again offer the Bainbridge Internship Program for the year 2021. This internship is a terrific opportunity for a local student to gain a hands-on understanding of the many operations that help Southold Historical Society preserve and share Southold's history for our community and future generations.

The internship requires the completion of 100 hours of service to the Society and is accompanied by a \$1,500 stipend. Potential candidates must be a sophomore through senior, living in Southold Town. The society has been welcoming interns for year, including some who went on for degrees in History, Anthropology, Law, as well as others who work in the non-profit sector.
